



Manufacturer's Certification Statement - 2011 Tax Credit
Regarding Eligible Building Envelope Components for Federal Energy Tax Credits

Paragon Door Designs, 7845 National Turnpike, Unit 150, Louisville, KY 40214 is the manufacturer of Paragon steel and fiberglass entry doors.

This certificate applies to exterior entry doors and sidelites and serves as verification that all Paragon Door Designs exterior entry door and sidelite products listed in the 2011 Paragon Entryway Collections catalog (#2011-11) EXCEPT those listed in this document qualify for the 2011 Federal Energy Tax Credit under Section 25C of the Internal Revenue Code as amended by H.R. 4853, the Tax Relief, Unemployment Insurance Reauthorization and Jobs Creation Act of 2010 by meeting minimum ENERGY STAR criteria in both U-Factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC).

Paragon Model Numbers that DO NOT meet meet minimum ENERGY STAR criteria:

Steel Entry Doors:

Table with 3 columns: Model Number, Product Code, and Price. Lists models like 20, 21, 21-WRMB, 22-IM, 22-WMRMB, 61, 61-WRMB, 63-IM, 63-WMRMB, 68, 69-IM with their respective codes and prices.

Steel Patio Doors:

Table with 2 columns: Model Number and Price. Lists models P-150 21, P-150 21-WRMB, P-150 22-IM, P-150 22-WMRMB.

Steel Sidelites:

Table with 2 columns: Model Number and Price. Lists models 3-IM, 4, 4-WRMB, 19, 185, 285, 485.

Fiberglass Entry Doors:

Table with 3 columns: Model Number, Product Code, and Price. Lists models like 20, 21, 21-WRMB, 22-IM, 22-WMRMB, 61, 61-WRMB, 63-IM, 63-WMRMB, 68, 69-IM with their respective codes and prices.

Fiberglass Patio Doors:

Table with 2 columns: Model Number and Price. Lists models P-150 21, P-150 21-WRMB, P-150 22-IM, P-150 22-WMRMB.

Fiberglass Sidelites:

Table with 2 columns: Model Number and Price. Lists models 3-IM, 4, 4-WRMB, 19, 185, 285, 485.

NOTE: Model numbers highlighted can meet minimum ENERGY STAR criteria and qualify for the tax credit by adding Low-E or Low-E with Argon option.

Taxpayers claiming a credit for an Eligible Building Envelope Component should save the purchase receipt with tax documents along with this certification statement as part of the taxpayer's records. Installation of the qualifying products must occur between January 1, 2011 and December 31, 2011.

NOTE: As in all tax matters, the taxpayer is advised to consult their tax advisor to determine whether they qualify for any potential income tax benefits.
